Pre Purchase Clinical and Moving Examination (\$350): The clinical examination begins with a comprehensive evaluation of the horse's respiratory, cardiovascular, musculoskeletal, and gastrointestinal systems. A moving evaluation and neurological exam will be performed.

Flexions of the forelimb and hind limbs will be evaluated. Also, under direction of the veterinarian, the horse may be observed under saddle.

CBC and Chemistry (\$150): *Optional* A complete blood count (CBC) and chemistry panel will be taken upon buyer's request. These tests are one of the most common blood tests performed to help you diagnose various infectious and abnormal conditions of the body.

Drug Screen (\$375): *Optional* A drug screen will be taken upon buyer's request. This test is performed to screen for multiple drugs utilizing enzyme-linked immunosorbent assays.

Digital Radiographic Examination (\$52 per view): *Optional* Following the movement portion of the examination, digital radiographs will be obtained upon buyer's request. It is standard in our comprehensive pre-purchase examination, to remove the horse's front shoes in order to obtain the best quality radiographs of the front feet. Exceptions will need to be discussed with the veterinarian performing the examination. More advanced diagnostics, such as ultrasound, may be indicated if swelling, thickening, or sensitivity of the tendons or ligaments is palpated.
